

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1500.00, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the office of the Territorial Treasurer for the biennium ending March 31, 1949. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for said office for said biennium and shall be apportioned according to the following schedule:

Extra Clerical Help, January 1 to March 31, 1949	\$900.00
Printing, Postage, Office Supplies and Equipment and Contingent Ex- pense	\$600.00

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 3

AN ACT

[H. B. 291]

To pay the Massachusetts Bonding and Insurance Company \$5,417.68, excess payment made on their premium tax, as shown on their tax statement for the year 1946.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise

appropriated the sum of Five Thousand, Four Hundred Seventeen Dollars and Sixty-eight Cents (\$5,417.68) to pay the Massachusetts Bonding and Insurance Company for excess payments made to the Territory of Alaska during the years 1941 to 1945 inclusive, as shown on their 1946 tax statement, under premiums received on war contracts in connection with the Comprehensive Rating Plan. Refund for
over-payment.

CHAPTER 4

AN ACT

[H. B. 16]

To correct statutory language covering computation of per diem for Territorial officers and employees by amending Paragraph 5 of Section 11-4-1, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Paragraph 5 of Section 11-4-1, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5. Per Diem. Per Diem in lieu of subsistence, will be allowed at the rate of ten dollars (\$10.00) per day, to officials and employees when away from their home or official station, in the Territory's business. In computing per diem in lieu of subsistence, the calendar day shall constitute a per diem period; for fractional parts of a day, at the commencing or ending of continuous travel, constituting a travel period, one fourth of a calendar day will be allowed for each six hours or fraction thereof.
