

CHAPTER 31

AN ACT

[C. S. H. B. 17]

Amending Sec. 48-3-1 ACLA 1949, pertaining to coin-operated amusement devices and gaming devices, by adding thereto subsection (c); and amending Sec. 48-3-6 ACLA 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 48-3-1 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended by adding thereto subsection (c) reading as follows:

“(c) Persons who commence such amusement or gaming device operations: after March 31st of any year shall be taxed at three-fourths the amount stated for a full year; after July 1st of any year shall be taxed at one-half the amount stated for the full year; after September 1st of any year shall be taxed at one-fourth the amount stated for the full year.”

Section 2. That Sec. 48-3-6 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 48-3-6. APPORTIONMENT OF REVENUES BETWEEN MUNICIPALITY AND GENERAL FUND OF TERRITORY: LEVY OF ADDITIONAL FEES BY MUNICIPALITY: TIME OF PAYMENT: DISPOSITION OF OTHER REVENUES. One-half of all revenues derived under this Act from taxes levied on amusement devices or pinball or slot machines in operation within a municipality duly incorporated under the laws of the Territory of Alaska shall, except to those municipalities that

provide by ordinance for the payment of taxes and license fees by operation of machines covered under this Act, be paid over to said municipality. In the event said municipality shall levy any additional license fees on said machines, the said municipality shall lose all right to the refund of that part of the license tax herein mentioned. Payment of said one-half of revenues realized shall be made semi-annually, commencing on July 1, 1949. All other revenues derived under this Act shall be paid into the general fund of the Territory of Alaska.

CHAPTER 32

AN ACT

[H. B. 42]

Relating to Compulsory School Attendance, and the filing of complaints for violations; and amending Sec. 37-7-3 ACLA 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 37-7-3 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 37-7-3. REPORT OF VIOLATIONS: COMPLAINT: A R R E S T: PROCEEDINGS BEFORE UNITED STATES COMMISSIONER. It shall be the duty of the superintendent, principal or teacher of each public or private school to report all violations of this Article to the school board in the school district in which such school is situated, or to the Commissioner of
