Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 37

### AN ACT

[H. B. 55]

To appropriate the sum of \$900.60 for expenses of the Office of the Territorial Department of Labor for the biennium ending March 31, 1949; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of \$900.60, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the office of the Territorial Department of Labor for the biennium ending March 31, 1949. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for said office for

## CHAPTER 38

### AN ACT

[H. B. 65]

To empower City Councils, pursuant to referendums, to levy sales taxes within their respective municipalities; and amending subsection Ninth of Sec. 16-1-35 ACLA 1949.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That subsection Ninth of Sec. 16-1-35 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Two per cent  
maximum levy.

Ninth: (a) GENERAL TAX FOR SCHOOL AND MUNICIPAL PURPOSES. To assess, levy, and collect a general tax for school and municipal purposes not to exceed two per centum of the assessed valuation upon all real and personal property, and to enforce the collection of such
