

CHAPTER 54

AN ACT

[S. B. 15]

To increase the remuneration of Judges and Election Clerks at general elections; amending Sec. 38-5-31 ACLA 1949; and providing an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 38-5-31 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 38-5-31. COMPENSATION OF ELECTION JUDGES AND CLERKS. In each voting precinct organized and functioning as such in any General Territorial Election, the judges and clerks of election shall receive from the Territory of Alaska, in addition to the remuneration to which they shall be entitled from any other governmental source for the performance of the required work and services, such sum as will aggregate the sum of \$15.00 per day for each of them.

Appropriation.

Section 2. The sum of \$13,500.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the purposes of this Act for the period ending March 31, 1951.
