

CHAPTER 55

AN ACT

[Senate Committee Substitute for S. B. 9
and Committee Substitute for H. B. 34]

Appropriating \$50,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase and remodeling certain property adjacent to the Pioneers' Home to provide additional facilities for Pioneer Men and Women, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$50,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary to be expended by the Board of Trustees of the Pioneers' Home for acquisition and remodeling of that certain real property in the Town of Sitka, Alaska, adjacent to the Pioneers' Home, known and identified as the Tower Apartments now owned by Arthur and Corinne Franklin.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees of the Pioneers' Home is hereby authorized to effectuate acquisition of said property, in the name of the Territory, and to obtain good and sufficient conveyance thereof.

Section 3. Said Trustees are hereby authorized, after acquisition of said property, to expend so much of the remainder of the money appropriated herein as may be necessary to make such changes and improvements in and upon said premises as are appropriate to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
