

CHAPTER 77

AN ACT

[S. B. 59]

Pertaining to Narcotic Drugs and expanding the definition of said term; amending Subsection (14) of Sec. 40-3-1 ACLA 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Subsection (14) of Sec. 40-3-1 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(14) "Narcotic Drugs" means coca leaves, opium, cannabis, isonipecaine, amidone, isoamidone, keto-bemidone, and every other substance neither chemically nor physically distinguishable from them.

Narcotic drug.

(a) "Amidone" means any substance identified chemically as (4-4-Diphenyl-6-Dimethylamino-Heptanone-3), or any salt thereof, by whatever trade name designated.

Amidone.

(b) "Isoamidone" means any substance identified chemically as (4-4-Dyphenyl-5-Methyl-6-Dimethylaminohexanone-3), or any salt thereof, by whatever trade name designated.

Isoamidone.

(c) "Keto-Bemidone" means any substance identified chemically as [4-(3-Hydroxyphenyl)-1-Methyl-4-piperidyl ethyl ketone hydrochloride], or any salt thereof, by whatever trade-name designated.

Keto-Bemidone.
