

## CHAPTER 78

## AN ACT

[S. B. 70]

Authorizing Dissolution of Incorporated and Independent School Districts and prescribing the procedure therefor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Disincorporation.

Section 1. AUTHORITY TO DISINCORPORATE. There is hereby granted to the voters in incorporated school districts, organized under the provisions of Sections 37-3-11 to 37-3-20, inc., ACLA 1949, and in independent school districts, organized under provisions of Sections 37-3-41 to 37-3-50, inc., ACLA 1949, authority to dissolve said districts.

Section 2. PROCEDURE FOR DISSOLUTION. The procedure for said dissolution shall be the same as that under which municipal corporations may be dissolved, as provided in Sections 16-1-5 to 16-1-8 ACLA 1949, and shall be instituted by filing a petition signed by not less than ten percent of the persons owning real property but in no event less than twenty-five persons within the school district the dissolution of which is sought, said petition stating good and substantial reasons for said action. A three-fifths majority of the voters voting in favor of dissolution shall be required before an order of dissolution of the school district shall be entered.
