

CHAPTER 99

AN ACT

[S. B. 84]

To amend subsection (K) of Sec. 35-4-21 ACLA 1949 to allow licensing of liquor sales on boats and railroad buffet cars while in transit; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Subsection (K) of Sec. 35-4-21 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(K) COMMON CARRIER DISPENSARY LICENSES: A common carrier dispensary license shall give to the holder thereof the right to sell intoxicating liquors for consumption aboard a boat, or a railroad buffet car while in transit only. Provided, however, that no common carrier dispensary license shall be issued for any boat or vessel of less than 250 tons United States Custom House measurement. A common carrier dispensary license fee shall be \$250.00 for each such vessel, or buffet car so licensed.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
