

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That the sum of \$8,961.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of salaries to persons employed by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the present session, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

(A) For the salaries of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and Secretary of the Senate, \$20.00 per day for 27 days, which includes 10 days service in preparation of Journal; Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives, and Assistant Secretary of the Senate, \$17.50 per day for 27 days, which includes 10 days service in preparation of Journal; the sum of\$2,025.00

(B) For the salaries of the Judiciary Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Judiciary Clerk of the Senate, \$15.00 per day for 17 days; the sum of\$510.00

(C) For the salaries of the following employees of the Senate, for 17 days at \$14.00 per day,—Bill Clerk and Sergeant-at-Arms; the sum of\$476.00

(D) For the salaries of the following employees of the House of Representatives, for 17 days at \$14.00 per day,—Bill Clerk and Sergeant-at-Arms; the sum of\$476.00

(E) For the salaries of the following employees of the Senate, for 17 days at \$13.00 per day,—Enrolling Clerk, Engrossing Clerk, Three typists, Watchman, Messenger, Doorkeeper, Mimeograph operator; the sum of\$1,989.00

(F) For the salaries of the following employees of the House of Representatives, for 17 days at \$13.00 per day,—Enrolling Clerk, Engrossing Clerk, Stenographer, Seven Clerk-typists, Two Mimeograph Operators, Watchman, Doorkeeper, Messenger; the sum of\$3,315.00.

(G) For the salaries of the Chaplains of the House of Representatives and of the Senate; for 17 days at \$5.00 per day; the sum of\$170.00

2. That the sum of \$10,200.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of the salaries of the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the extraordinary session, at the rate of \$15.00 per day and that said sum be appropriated for such purpose.

3. That the sum of \$300.00, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of additional services rendered by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the extraordinary session, and this money is to be equally divided.

4. That the sum of \$300.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of compensation to such janitors and charwomen as are necessary to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature at this session.

5. That the sum of \$15.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of necessary telephone service for use of the Legislature during the present session.

6. That the sum of \$4,850.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of printing and binding of the Senate and House Journals, Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the Legislature during the present session.

7. That the sum of \$2,500.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase of mimeograph paper, typewriting paper, stencils, carbons and such

other material and supplies as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature during the present session.

8. That the sum of \$15,000.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the rate of \$15.00 per day for the members of the Legislature, for each day of attendance at a legislative session, together with travel time.

9. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives.

10. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
