HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 1

TO THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE
FIRST JUDICIAL DIVISION, ALASKA:

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Alaska, respectfully calls your attention to Section 35-2-188 ACLA 1949, the provisions of which have been in effect for many years, and further calls your attention to the following ostensible violations thereof:

An examination of the Auditor's files pertaining to the provisions of the Lobby Act above cited fails to disclose that Mr. W. C. Arnold and Mr. Al Anderson, longtime lobbyists for the fishing and mining industries, respectively, have, since 1945, filed a report of expenditures made by them in the furtherance of their work as lobbyists, and the Auditor's said files fail to show that the required reports have been filed by the companies or associations which said persons have represented.

THEREFORE, your Memorialist requests that you investigate this matter, or cause same to be investigated, and take such appropriate prosecutive steps as may be called for in the premises.
