

## House Resolutions

### HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, there is pending before the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the State of Oregon a measure designated as Senate Bill No. 43 which would extend to students from Alaska the privilege of attending institutions of higher learning in the State of Oregon without payment of out-of-state tuition; and,

WHEREAS, business and commercial ties between the State of Oregon and the Territory of Alaska are expanding and becoming stronger, to the advantage of both, such mutuality of interest indicating the desirability of strengthening cultural ties also; and,

WHEREAS, Alaskans generally appreciate the gesture of friendship extended by the people of the State of Oregon through the principle embodied in said Senate Bill No. 43:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19th Territorial Legislature of Alaska in regular session assembled that a vote of appreciation should be extended by this assembly to the members of the House of Representatives of the Oregon State Legislature complimenting them on the warm, friendly gesture represented by Senate Bill No. 43;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent by the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Alaska Legislature to the Speaker of the House of the Oregon Legislature, to the Hon. Lyle D. Thomas, Chairman of the Committee on Education of that body, and to Senator Richard Neuberger, author of Senate Bill No. 43.
