

A PROCLAMATION

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
TERRITORY OF ALASKA

OFFICE OF THE ACTING GOVERNOR OF THE
TERRITORY

WHEREAS, public necessity requires (as set for in the written notice to members issued herewith) that the Legislature of Alaska be convened in extraordinary session,

THEREFORE, I, Llewellyn M. Williams, Acting Governor of Alaska, by virtue of the authority vested in the Governor of Alaska by Section 6 of the Organic Act of Alaska, as amended by the Act of April 18, 1940, Chapter 105, Sec. 1, 54 Stat. 111, 48 USCA Sec. 74,

DO HEREBY convene the Nineteenth Legislature of the Territory of Alaska to meet in extraordinary session at the City of Juneau, Alaska, at 10 o'clock A. M., on Thursday, January 6, 1949, and to remain in session until and including January 22, 1949, for the following objects:

To consider and act upon legislation to provide such revenues for the Territory as the Legislature may deem necessary or advisable to remedy the critical financial condition of the Territory of Alaska.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the undersigned, in the absence of the Governor of Alaska from the Territory of Alaska, have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed the Seal of the Territory of Alaska this 17th day of December, 1948, at the Capital City, Juneau, Alaska.
