

Senate Joint Resolutions

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, by Senate Joint Resolution No. 1 passed by the 1947 Legislature of Alaska, the Department of Public Welfare of the Territory of Alaska was authorized to pay to the Maynard Columbus Hospital at Nome, Alaska, an amount not exceeding \$10.00 per day for the permanent hospitalization and medical care of Axel Werner out of funds appropriated for allowance to aged residents of the Territory of Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, the said Axel Werner has now improved in health to the extent that it is not necessary that he be confined to said hospital; and,

WHEREAS, said Axel Werner would be eligible to apply for and receive Old Age Assistance allowances from the Department of Public Welfare of the Territory of Alaska;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Welfare of the Territory of Alaska is hereby instructed to discontinue payment of the amounts authorized by Senate Joint Resolution No. 1 of the Eighteenth Regular Session of the Alaska Legislature to the Maynard Columbus Hospital at Nome for the permanent hospitalization and medical care of Axel Werner, such discontinuance of payment to be effective as of March 31, 1949.
