

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the two mimeograph machines and the two mimeoscopes purchased for use by the House and Senate clerical force shall be serviced by a serviceman, well boxed for storage and placed in storage. That under no circumstances shall they be loaned or used by any person, persons or by any Territorial or Federal official or any department thereof.

That the typewriters now in use may be loaned or taken for use by other Territorial agencies; all other material and supplies to be stored for use of succeeding legislatures.

That twenty new typewriters shall be purchased, ten for the Senate and ten for the House, to be available at least five days before the Legislature next convenes, which new typewriters shall not be made available to anyone except the Legislature.

That there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$3,500.00 or so much thereof as is necessary to be expended by the Auditor for purchase of the said typewriters and storage thereof, and to pay for the servicing and storage of other property and supplies of the Legislature, including such additional clerical hire and other incidental expense as may be required in the premises.
