SENATE MEMORIAL NO. 1

TO THE TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY ENGINEER AND TO THE ALASKA AERONAUTICS AND COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION:

Your Memorialist, the Senate of the Alaska Legislature, in Nineteenth Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits:

WHEREAS, the communities of Kotzebue and Ft. Yukon, Alaska, not only because of their location above the Arctic Circle, but also because of their local color and appeal to the tourist trade, have been annually attracting more and more tourists; and

WHEREAS, the airports at these two places are inadequate, and in the case of Kotzebue the field has been declared by the CAA to be unsafe for multi-engined aircraft; and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of the entire Territory to develop our tourist trade to the utmost capacity; and

WHEREAS, Federal funds are now available to help in the construction of such airports;

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist urges that you allot and make available the sum of \$25,000.00 for airport construction in each of the above named localities, to be used as matching funds for the purpose of securing Federal assistance.
