

## CHAPTER 134

## AN ACT

[H. B. 162]

To appropriate the sum of \$17,973,645.16 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the Biennium beginning April 1, 1951 and ending March 31, 1953, and for the school biennium beginning July 1, 1951 and ending June 30, 1953, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of \$17,973,645.16 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the expenses of the Territory for the biennium commencing April 1, 1951 and ending March 31, 1953, and for the school biennium commencing July 1, 1951 and ending June 30, 1953, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

Section 2. REPEAL. Ch. 122, S.L.A. 1949 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. All Territorial employees whose salaries have not been otherwise increased above the greatest amount which they received during the 1949-1951 biennium shall be increased 8% per annum, provided, however, that such increase shall not be applied to any personnel whose salaries are established at \$5,000.00 or more per annum. The sum of \$30,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated to carry out the provisions of this section.

Section 4. This Act shall become effective April 1, 1951.
