

CHAPTER 13

AN ACT

[H. B. 96]

Amending sub-paragraph (c) of Section 21-3-12 ACLA 1949 by deleting the requirement that consents to adoption of minors of illegitimate birth contain information in regard to the putative father and requirements of notification to the putative father

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That sub-paragraph (c) of Section 21-3-12 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Adoption
consent

(c) If the person to be adopted be a minor of illegitimate birth, not subsequently legitimized, then by his mother if living, except as hereinafter provided. In adoptions in this category the consent of the natural father need not be obtained or notice given him.

CHAPTER 14

AN ACT

[H. B. 89]

To appropriate the sum of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$7,700.00) as a deficiency appropriation to be used in paying United States Commissioners and Clerks of Court for recording and reporting Vital Statistics records; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$7,700.00) not otherwise appropriated, or so much as may be necessary, be appropriated for the use of the Registrar of Vital Statistics in paying United States Commissioners and Clerks of Court for recording and reporting Vital Statistics certificates for the biennium ending March 31, 1951.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 15

AN ACT

[H. B. 104]

Relating to Lobbying in Alaska; and amending Section 35-2-181 ACLA 1949, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 6, Session Laws of Alaska 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 35-2-181 ACLA 1949, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 6, Session Laws of Alaska, 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 35-2-181. NAME OF LOBBYIST AND OTHER INFORMATION TO BE FURNISHED AUDITOR. Whoever, being a person, firm, corporation or association, engages or assigns any person already regularly employed by said per-
