

## CHAPTER 19

## AN ACT

[H. B. 42]

To appropriate the sum of \$2,936.75 for expenses of the Territorial Board of Public Accountancy for the biennium ending March 31, 1951; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of \$2,936.75 is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the Territorial Board of Public Accountancy for the biennium ending March 31, 1951. This appropriation shall be in addition to monies heretofore appropriated for said Board for said biennium, and shall be apportioned as follows:
