

Alaska to warrant probate, and no such probate proceedings were ever started in Alaska, and that his terminal leave with pay has never been satisfied, notwithstanding numerous requests from his widow for appropriate action; and

WHEREAS, his two sons and daughter, constituting all of his remaining heirs at law, have signed disclaimers in favor of their mother, the said Barbara Smith;

NOW THEREFORE, there is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$566.41, to be drawn in favor of said Barbara Smith in full settlement of her said deceased husband's terminal leave pay, upon a voucher approved by the Territorial Treasurer.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 31

AN ACT

[S. B. 14]

Amending Sec. 4-4-5 ACLA 1949 pertaining to fees allowed legislative witnesses; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 4-4-5 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Mileage
rate.

Sec. 4-4-5. WITNESS FEES AND MILEAGE. All persons appearing before any of the bodies herein designated, in response to a subpoena as herein provided shall be paid twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each day's attendance before such body, and for the time necessary in coming and returning to his or her place of residence and mileage at the rate of 15 cents per mile for the distance traveled in going to and returning from the place of attendance, from the monies in the territorial treasury, and the Territorial Treasurer shall pay said fees and mileage to any witness upon presentation by him of a certificate of attendance and mileage due, signed by the presiding officer of the House which authorized issuance of subpoena.

CHAPTER 32

AN ACT

[S. B. 16]

Respecting eligibility of persons to serve as members of Territorial Boards and Commissions; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:
