Sec. 4-4-5. WITNESS FEES AND MILEAGE. All persons appearing before any of the bodies herein designated, in response to a subpoena as herein provided shall be paid twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each day's attendance before such body, and for the time necessary in coming and returning to his or her place of residence and mileage at the rate of 15 cents per mile for the distance traveled in going to and returning from the place of attendance, from the monies in the territorial treasury, and the Territorial Treasurer shall pay said fees and mileage to any witness upon presentation by him of a certificate of attendance and mileage due, signed by the presiding officer of the House which authorized issuance of subpoena.

## CHAPTER 32

### AN ACT

[S. B. 16]

Respecting eligibility of persons to serve as members of Territorial Boards and Commissions; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Legislators

to Boards.

Section 1. From and after the effective date of this Act no member of the Alaska Legislature shall be appointed to serve on any Territorial Board or Commis-

sion; and the Governor, as well as any other authority empowered to make appointments to any Board or Commission under the purview of this Act, shall no longer regard such persons as so eligible with respect to the times above mentioned.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. <sup>Emergency clause.</sup>

## CHAPTER 33

### AN ACT

[S. B. 19]

To amend Paragraph 5 of Section 11-4-1 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 4 S.L.A. 1949, by increasing the rate of per diem; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Paragraph 5 of Sec. 11-4-1 ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 4 S.L.A. 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5. Per Diem. Per Diem in lieu of subsistence, will be allowed at the rate of twelve dollars (\$12.00) per day, to officials and employees when away from their homes or official station, in the Territory's business. In computing per diem in lieu of subsistence, the calendar day shall constitute a per diem period; for fractional parts of a day, at the commencing or
