

CHAPTER 35

AN ACT

[S. B. 26]

To amend Section 60-1-3 and Section 60-1-4, ACLA 1949, relating to the distribution of real and personal property and its escheat if the intestate shall leave no lineal descendants, husband, widow, or kindred, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Sub-paragraph 7, Section 60-1-3, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 60-1-3(7). If the intestate shall leave no lineal descendants or kindred, such property shall escheat to the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. Sub-paragraph 6, Section 60-1-4, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 60-1-4(6). If there be no husband, widow, or kindred of the intestate, the whole of such residue shall escheat to the Territory of Alaska.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared and this Act shall become effective upon its passage and approval

CHAPTER 36

AN ACT

[S. B. 29]

Directing the Treasurer to surrender, without consideration, Bonds aggregating \$500.00 issued by the Valley Hospital Association of Palmer, Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Territory, by escheat, having become owner of five bonds of the face value of \$100.00 each

issued by the Valley Hospital Association of Palmer, Alaska, under date of May 6, 1948, the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to surrender said bonds, without consideration, to said Hospital Association.

CHAPTER 37

AN ACT

[S. B. 31]

To appropriate the sum of \$9,469.36 to reimburse the Alaska World War II Veterans' Revolving Fund for the cost of audits made of the accounts of the Veterans' Affairs Commission; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$9,469.36, to be paid to the Alaska World War II Veterans' Revolving Fund upon a voucher approved by the Territorial Treasurer, as reimbursement to said Veterans' Revolving Fund of monies expended for the cost of audits made of the accounts of the Veterans' Affairs Commission.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
