

CHAPTER 38

AN ACT

[S. B. 32]

Amending Section 42-2-10 ACLA 1949 so as to include persons to membership without medical examination in non-profit mutual beneficial insurance societies incorporated under the laws of Alaska, where the maximum insurance benefit does not exceed \$2,500.00.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 42-2-10 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

42-2-10. MEMBERS: EXAMINATION AND CERTIFICATE: EXCEPTIONS. Any non-profit benefit society may admit to membership any person not less than eighteen nor more than sixty-five years of age, who has been examined by a legally qualified practicing physician, and no person shall be admitted to membership until a certificate duly executed by such physician shall have been filed with the society. Such certificate shall be filed and preserved by the society as a permanent record. Provided, however, that such persons may be admitted to membership in non-profit mutual beneficial insurance societies incorporated under the laws of Alaska without medical examination where the maximum insurance benefits to be derived from such membership do not exceed \$2,500.00.
