

Section 19.

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law, the provisions of this act shall control, excepting as to trust receipts and pledge transactions entered into before this act, as hereby added, takes effect.

Section 20.

If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act and its application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 21.

This act may be cited as the "Uniform Trust Receipts Law".

Amending Sec. 39-5-3 ACLA 1949, relating to the Fisheries Experimental Commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 39-5-3 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

COMMISSION: CREATION: MEMBERS AND THEIR APPOINTMENT. There is hereby established a Fisheries Experimental Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," consisting of the Fisheries Technologist in charge of the Ketchikan Fisheries Experimental Laboratory, and two members to be appointed by the Governor of Alaska with the advice and consent of the Legislature.

CHAPTER 42

AN ACT

[H. B. 115]

To extend election laws and powers of first class cities relating to public utilities, airports, public service rates, franchises, acquisition and disposition of property, motor vehicle regulations and schools, to second class cities or towns; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Powers.

Section 1. All laws and parts of laws of the Territory of Alaska empowering and regulating first class cities on public utilities, airports, public service rates, franchises, acquisition and disposition of property, motor vehicles, and schools, are hereby extended and made applicable to second class cities or towns.
