

CHAPTER 44

AN ACT

[S. B. 7]

Amending Sec. 16-1-64 ACLA 1949 pertaining to bond furnished by municipal treasurer.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sec. 16-1-64 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-1-64. Municipal treasurer: Bond. The municipal treasurer shall be the custodian of all the monies of the city; provided, that said treasurer shall pay over to the treasurer of the school board all monies available for the maintenance of schools. He shall keep an itemized, full and correct account of all monies received and disbursed, and he shall pay out no money except upon an order signed by the mayor and countersigned by the clerk, and specifying the object and purpose of the payment and the page and book of the record of the council proceedings where such payment is shown to have been authorized, and no such order shall be issued except upon vote of four members of the council at a meeting in which five members, or four members and the mayor, are present. He shall, before entering upon the duties of his office, give his bond to the city with sufficient sureties to be approved by the council in such sum as the council may direct, but not less than twenty-five per cent of the annual total of collectible property taxes, and in no case shall a bond in excess of One Hundred Thousand Dollars be required, which bond shall be conditioned that he

will faithfully and honestly collect, keep and disburse all the monies belonging to the city, which bond shall be filed with and kept by the municipal clerk.

## CHAPTER 45

### AN ACT

[H. B. 150]

Authorizing the Auditor to call for and award bids for the reprinting of the 1949 Session Laws; appropriating the sum of \$5,357.70 to cover the cost thereof; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Auditor of Alaska is hereby authorized to call for and award bids for the reprinting of not more than 250 copies of the Session Laws of 1949.

**Appropriation.**

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,357.70, or so much thereof as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**Emergency clause.**

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
