CHAPTER 73

AN ACT

[S. B. 54]

To compensate Alaska Coachways for standby expenses incurred during the polio epidemic in the Fairbanks Area during which time schools were closed; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,356.86 is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to compensate Alaska Coachways, a carrier which had contracted with the Territory of Alaska to transport school children to school in the Fairbanks Independent School District during the school year 1950-51, for the standby expenses; including wages of extra drivers, incurred by such carrier in not being able to transport children to said school during the twenty-two days that such schools were closed between September 29 and November 20, 1950, because of a polio epidemic in the Fairbanks area.

Section 2. Payment under this appropriation shall be made upon a voucher approved by the Commissioner of Education for the Territory of Alaska.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency clause.

CHAPTER 74

AN ACT

[S. B. 42]

To secure the expression of opinion of the voters of the Territory of Alaska on the question whether the Territory shall issue general obligation bonds in a sum not exceeding \$12,500,000 to be used solely for the construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, equipment, and installation of public school buildings and facilities, and authorizing, should 55% of the voters express their approval of the issuance of such bonds, the Board of Administration to issue and cause the issuance of and to sell general obligation bonds of the Territory in a sum of not exceeding \$12,500,000 and to use the proceeds derived from said bonds solely for the aforesaid purposes, and to incur and pay all expenses reasonably necessarily incurred in the issuance and sale of said bonds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There shall be submitted to the voters of the Territory at the next special or the next general election, whichever is first held, the question: whether the Territory shall issue its general obligation bonds in a sum of not exceeding \$12,500,000 to be used solely for the construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, equipment, and installation of public school buildings and facilities.
