

CHAPTER 83

AN ACT

[H. B. 138]

To amend Section 44-2-12, ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 87, Session Laws of Alaska, 1949, pertaining to Alaska World War II Veterans, validating instruments executed in the name of "Veterans' Affairs Commission."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 44-2-12, A.C.L.A., 1949, as amended by Chapter 87, Session Laws of Alaska, 1949, is hereby amended by adding thereto, immediately after Subsection (c) (3) thereof, the following Subsection:

(4) That the deeds, mortgages, assignments or other documents made, executed and delivered in conformity with the provisions of Section 44-2-11 through 44-2-14, A.C.L.A., 1949, as amended by Chapter 87, Session Laws of Alaska, 1949, and as otherwise required by law, in which the designation "Veterans' Affairs Commission" appears, whether as grantor, grantee, mortgagee, assignor, assignee, or otherwise, be and they are hereby validated and confirmed, and all obligations incurred under the provisions of any such deed, mortgage, assignment or other instrument by the Territory of Alaska, the Alaska World War II Veterans' Board, or the Commissioner of Veterans' Affairs, in his official capacity, are hereby declared to be good, valid and subsisting obligations, and the covenants, conditions and provisions, if any, prescribed to be kept, paid, performed or observed, imposed upon any party described in any such instrument shall be discharged as therein set forth, the fact that the

officer executing and delivering any such instrument added to his signature the description "Veterans' Affairs Commission", notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 84

AN ACT

[H. B. 98]

Relating to the registration and licensing of professional engineers and architects; amending Sec. 35-2-146 ACLA 1949, Sec. 35-2-149 ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 111 S. L. A. 1949, and Sec. 35-2-155 ACLA 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 35-2-146 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 35-2-146. REGISTRATION FUND: EXPENSES: PAYMENT: REPORT: LIST OF REGISTRANTS. The fees derived from the operation of this Act shall be paid into a special fund in the Territorial Treasury, to be known as the engineers and architects registration fund, which is hereby created. If, at the end of any calendar year, the total amount in said Fund shall exceed \$10,000.00, then all moneys in excess of \$10,000.00 shall be covered into the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury. Warrants for the payment of necessary expenses incurred by this board in the performance of
