

CHAPTER 89

AN ACT

[H. B. 147]

To secure an expression of the voters of the Territory of Alaska on the question as to whether the operation and control of the Territorial fisheries should be turned over to the Territory by Congress.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. At the general Territorial election in 1952, there shall be submitted to the voters of the Territory of Alaska, on a separate ballot in substantially the form indicated herein, the following question:

REFERENDUM BALLOT

Ballot
question.

Should complete control and operation of the Territorial fisheries be turned over to the Territory of Alaska by Congress?

(no)

Section 2. Such ballots shall be distributed to each voting precinct in the same number as is now provided by law for the distribution of general election ballots.

Canvass of
returns.

Section 3. The returns of such referendum shall be canvassed in the manner prescribed for general elections, and the result shall be certified and transmitted by the Secretary of the Territory to the Legislature at the regular session in January 1953, in order that it may take such action as may be necessary in conformance with the result of such referendum.
