HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA that

the Attorney General of Alaska is hereby directed to re-examine the opinion of his office delivered to the Legislature four years ago that the prohibition in the Organic Act of Alaska against the enactment by the Legislature of special or local laws extends to appropriations, and report such re-examination to the House of Representatives within twenty days of the adoption of this resolution.

House Joint Resolutions

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE IN TWENTIETH REGULAR
SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That the sum of \$36,725.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of salaries to persons employed by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the present session, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

(A) For the salaries of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and Secretary of the Senate, \$21.00 per day for 71 days, which includes 11 days service in preparation of Journal; the Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives, \$18.50 per day for 71 days which includes 11 days service in preparation of Journal; two assistant Secretaries of the Senate, one at \$18.50 per day for 57 days and one at \$18.50 per day for 68 days, which includes 11 days service in preparation of Journal; the sum of.....\$6,608.00

(B) For the salaries of the Judiciary Clerk of the House of Representatives, \$16.00 per day for 60 days, and Judiciary Clerk of the Senate, \$16.00 per day for 57 days; the Bill Clerk of the House of Representatives, \$16.00 per day for 66 days, and Bill Clerk of the Senate, \$16.00 per day for 63 days, which includes 6 days services to close the session properly, the sum of.....\$3,936.00

(C) For the salaries of the Sergeant-at-Arms of the House of Representatives, \$15.00 per day for 60 days, and the Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate, \$15.00 per day for 57 days; the sum of...\$1,755.00

(D) For the salaries of the following employees of the Senate, for 57 days at \$14.00 per day, an Enrolling Clerk, two Stenographers, Engrossing Clerk, Five Typists, Watchman, Messenger, Doorkeeper, Mimeograph Operator; the sum of.....\$10,374.00

(E) For the salaries of the following employees of the House of Representatives, for 60 days at \$14.00 per day, an Enrolling Clerk, Engrossing Clerk, Stenographer, Mail Clerk, Six Clerk-typists, Two Mimeograph Operators, Watchman, Doorkeeper, Messenger; the sum of\$12,600.00

(F) For the salaries of the Chaplain of the House of Representatives, for 60 days at \$6.00 per day; and for the Chaplain of the Senate, 57 days at \$6.00 per day, the sum of.....\$702.00

(G) For the salary of one employee in the Territorial Auditor's Office, performing services directly connected with the functions of the Auditor in his service to the Legislature; the sum of\$750.00

2. That the sum of \$400.00, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of additional services rendered by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-

sentatives of the Territory of Alaska during the regular session, and this money is to be equally divided.

3. That the sum of \$2,000.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of compensation to such janitors and charwomen as are necessary to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the legislature at this session.

4. That the sum of \$66.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of necessary telephone service for use of the Legislature during the present session.

5. That the sum of \$39,000.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of printing and binding of the Senate and House Journals, Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the Legislature during the present session.

6. That the sum of \$5,000.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the purchase of mimeograph paper, typewriting paper, stencils, carbons and such other material and supplies as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature during the present session.

7. That the sum of \$37,470.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the rate of \$15.00 per day for the members of the Legislature, 62 days each for regular members of both Houses and 71 days for the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House.

8. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated out of the monies of the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to be paid \$50.00 to each member of the House and Sen-

ate, as the estimated amount necessary to defray costs of mailing, telegraphing and otherwise communicating with constituents during this session.

9. That the sum of \$500.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated to be used as a Contingent Fund. This fund to be divided \$300.00 to the House of Representatives and \$200.00 to the Senate for use in defraying costs of extra mailing of mass nature or other contingencies and same to be drawn on by the authority of the Speaker of the House of Representatives or President of the Senate, respectively.

10. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee on Territorial Offices and Institutions in the Senate and the Committee on Territorial Institutions in the House of Representatives be and they are hereby authorized and directed to provide for the transportation of a committee from the Senate and a committee from the House of Representatives from Juneau, Alaska, to Sitka and return, said committees to inspect and examine the Pioneer's Home at Sitka, Alaska, and report to the Legislature their findings and recommendations. That for the purpose of defraying the cost of transportation of said committee there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for such purpose.

11. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

12. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
