

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Any resident of Alaska of legal age is hereby empowered to donate by written instrument while living one of his or her eyes or both of his or her eyes to any individual, partnership, association, corporation or hospital, the eye or eyes so donated to be removed (without the consent of the heirs or devisees of the donor) after the death of the donor by any physician licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the Territory of Alaska.

## CHAPTER 12

### AN ACT

[S. B. 11]

To authorize payment of salary to Jovita L. Cabigas for services rendered in the Department of Taxation; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Department of Taxation is hereby authorized to pay to Jovita L. Cabigas, upon a duly presented voucher properly approved, the sum of \$130.00 in payment of clerical services rendered by her in the Department

## CHAPTER 13

### AN ACT

[S. B. 39]

Appropriating funds to reimburse individuals and corporations for monies advanced to complete the construction of the Territorial Office Building at Juneau, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$275,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to reimburse the persons and corporations who made advances to complete the construction of the Territorial Office Building at Juneau, Alaska. Said advances, together with interest accrued at the rate of five (5%) per cent per annum shall be paid from this appropriation by the Treasurer upon vouchers approved by J. F. Mullen, President of the B. M. Behrends Bank of Juneau, Alaska, Trustee for said persons and corporations, and, further, the Treasurer shall pay to said Bank, out of said appropriation, the sum of \$300.00 as full compensation for services rendered as such Trustee.
