AN ACT

[H. B. 92]

Relating to per diem and transportation for members of Territorial boards and commissions; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. From and after the effective date of this Act, the following provisions relating to per diem and transportation shall govern exclusively, and shall supersede all other provisions of law, with respect to a member of any Territorial board, commission, committee, or other similar body of persons of the Territory organized or established under authority of law, but excluding all other Territorial employees, who is otherwise entitled by law to receive from the Territory payments for expenses of transportation and for reimbursement, or for per diem in lieu of reimbursement, for other expenses, incident to his duties as such member:

General coverage.

(a) With respect to transportation, such member shall be entitled either to the use of Territorial transportation requests, or to be reimbursed for expenses of transportation, to the same extent, in the same manner and under the same conditions as provided for Territorial officials and employees by the provisions of subsections 3 and 4 of Section 11-4-1 ACLA 1949, as amended or as hereafter amended.

Transportation expenses,

(b) With respect to reimbursements for other expenses, such member shall be entitled to per diem and compensation, the combination of which shall be at the rate of \$20.00 per day for each day, or portion thereof, spent on official business incident to his duties as such member.

Per diem and compensation rate.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Emergency clause.
