CHAPTER 45

AN ACT

[H. B. 123]

To prohibit electioneering of any kind at or near polling places on election days.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. No person shall do any electioneering, circulate cards or handbills of any kind, post political signs or posters, hand out marked ballots, or solicit signatures to any political petition on election day within any polling place, or any building in which an election is being held, or within one hundred feet thereof, nor obstruct the doors or entries thereto, or prevent free ingress to and egress from said building. Whoever violates any provision of this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Electioneering prohibited near polls on election days.

Penalty.

CHAPTER 46

AN ACT

[H. B. 133]

To repeal Section 37-2-56 ACLA 1949, relating to an annual school census, and establishing an effective date .

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Annual school
census repealed.

Section 1. That Section 37-2-56 ACLA 1949, is hereby repealed.

Effective date.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 47

AN ACT

[H. B. 146]

To appropriate the sum of \$8,182.66 for expenses of the Office of Highway Engineer for the biennium ending March 31, 1953; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Deficiency
appropriation.

Section 1. The sum of \$8,182.66 is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the Office of the Highway Engineer for the biennium ending March 31, 1953. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for said office for said biennium, and shall be expended for repair of the Territorial Building.

Emergency clause.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 48

AN ACT

[S.S.B. 25]

To authorize refund of all non-resident fishermen's licenses collected by the Tax Commissioner for the years 1949, 1950, and 1951, in excess of \$5.00 per annum on each non-resident fisherman, and declaring an emergency.
