CHAPTER 47

AN ACT

[H. B. 146]

To appropriate the sum of \$8,182.66 for expenses of the Office of Highway Engineer for the biennium ending March 31, 1953; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Deficiency
appropriation.

Section 1. The sum of \$8,182.66 is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the Office of the Highway Engineer for the biennium ending March 31, 1953. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for said office for said biennium, and shall be expended for repair of the Territorial Building.

Emergency clause.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 48

AN ACT

[S.S.B. 25]

To authorize refund of all non-resident fishermen's licenses collected by the Tax Commissioner for the years 1949, 1950, and 1951, in excess of \$5.00 per annum on each non-resident fisherman, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Treasurer of the Territory is authorized, empowered and directed to refund, on application, all non-resident fishermen's license fees collected by him under the provisions of Chapter 66, Session Laws of Alaska 1949, in excess of \$5.00 each per annum, and that the refund be made to the individuals in all cases where the fee was paid by them or deducted from their wages or earnings, and that it be paid to the employers and persons purchasing fish from non-resident fishermen in all cases where the employer or the persons purchasing fish paid the tax without reimbursement from the fisherman; provided, however, that no payment shall be made under this Act unless applications are filed with the Tax Commissioner within one (1) year from the date of the passage and approval of this Act. All payments shall be without interest and shall be made from funds in the hands of the Territorial Treasurer in the usual manner upon vouchers issued by the Tax Commissioner. Before receiving any refund under this Act, the claimant therefor shall fully release the Territory from all claims that he or it may have in connection with license fees paid under the provisions of Chapter 66, Session Laws of Alaska 1949.

Section 2. Any person or corporation knowingly collecting or receiving, and retaining refund of any license fee not paid by him or it, or lawfully assigned to such person or corporation, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00.
