CHAPTER 56

AN ACT

[S. B. 73]

To authorize the construction of an addition to the Pioneers' Home at Sitka, Alaska; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Hospital addition.

Section 1. The Trustees of the Alaska Pioneers' Home are authorized and directed to cause to be constructed and equipped a modern fireproof addition to the Pioneers' Home building at Sitka, Alaska, for the use, occupancy and accommodation of aged Alaska pioneer men and women, for hospitalization of the patrons of said Home and, in emergency cases, for hospitalization of residents of Sitka, Alaska, and others requiring medical or surgical facilities.

Emergency use.

Section 2. The Trustees are authorized to contract on behalf of the Territory, to direct and supervise the expenditure of any appropriation made for such construction and equipping, and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Act.

Section 3. Moneys appropriated to carry out the purposes of this Act may be utilized and expended in conjunction with moneys or other aid made available for such purposes by the Federal Government.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 57

AN ACT

[S. B. 75]

To create, provide for and promote the establishment of community colleges within the Territory of Alaska, and to provide for the financial support and for the operation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. DEFINITIONS. As used in this Act the following words and terms shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates a different meaning.

(a) "Community college" shall mean a program to be set up by qualified school districts of the Territory of Alaska, as hereinafter defined, including vocational and academic instruction applicable to grades thirteen through fourteen and eligible for accreditation by the University of Alaska in the manner hereinafter provided.

"Community college" defined.

(b) "Qualified school district" shall mean any school district organized under the laws of the Territory of Alaska.

"Qualified school district" defined.

(1) which shall make application to the Board of Regents for participation in the community college program;

(2) which shall satisfy the accreditation standards of the University of Alaska according to the rules and regulations of the Board of Regents;

(3) which has had an average daily membership during the previous school year of at least one hundred seventy-five high school students;
