

## CHAPTER 70

## AN ACT

[S. B. 95]

To permit minors to operate motor bicycles or motor scooters.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, or any rule or regulation of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, to the contrary, permits for the operation of motor bicycles or motor scooters may be issued to persons between the ages of thirteen and sixteen years with the consent of the parents or guardians. The term "motor bicycle" or "motor scooter" shall mean any bicycle or motor scooter that is self-propelled, but shall not include a motorcycle.

Minors covered.

"Motor bicycle" and "motor scooter" defined.

Section 2. Permits may be issued, subject to the provisions of Section 1 of this Act, by any police officer or highway patrolman in the Territory of Alaska who is charged with the enforcement of traffic laws or regulations.

Permits.

Section 3. Permits for operating motor bicycles or motor scooters may be revoked and penalties assessed in the same manner prescribed by law or regulation for violations in the operation of other motor vehicles.

## CHAPTER 71

## AN ACT

[H. B. 167]

To amend Sec. 61-13-21 ACLA 1949, relating to the order of payment of charges and claims against estates.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sec. 61-13-21 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

have been presented and allowed, or presented and disallowed but subsequently established by judgment within the first six months, after the date of the notice of appointment of the executor or administrator, shall be paid in the following order, and those presented and allowed or established in like manner with each succeeding period of six months thereafter during the continuance of the administration in the same manner: First, funeral charges and expenses of last illness; second, taxes of whatever nature due the United States for which lien claim has been filed for record in accordance with Sec. 48-9-1 ACLA 1949; third, taxes of whatever nature due the Territory of Alaska for which it holds a prior, paramount lien; fourth, all other taxes of whatever nature to whomsoever due and all debts which at decedent's death were a lien upon his property or any right or interest therein according to the respective priority of the several liens of such taxes and debts; fifth, debts preferred by the bankruptcy laws of the United States and debts due employees of decedent for wages earned within the ninety days immediately preceding the death of the decedent; sixth, all other claims against the estate.
