

tional 30 days or fraction thereof during which such failure continues, not exceeding 25% in the aggregate. The amount so added to any tax shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner and as a part of the tax unless the tax has been paid before the discovery of the neglect, in which case the amount so added should be collected in the same manner as the tax; Provided, that in all cases of delinquency the legal rate of interest shall be assessed.

CHAPTER 80

AN ACT

[H. B. 112]

Transferring a certain parcel of land at Sitka, Alaska, to the City of Sitka, and authorizing, empowering and directing the Governor to execute the necessary deeds; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby transferred, in consideration of the payment of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR, from the Territory of Alaska to the City of Sitka, Alaska, a municipal corporation, for street-widening purposes and to be dedicated to the public as a public street, the following-described tracts of land in the City of Sitka, Alaska, abutting on Lincoln, Seward and Barracks Streets, particularly described as follows:

TRACT I — Abutting Lincoln Street.

Beginning at Corner No. 1, which is identical with Corner No. 1, the southwest corner of the Pioneers' Home Tract; thence N 28° 30' W a distance of 38.07 ft. along Front Street to Corner No. 2; thence along the arc of a circle whose radius is 20.00 ft. and whose center lies easterly,

a distance of 31.48 ft. to Corner No. 3; thence N 61° 19' E a distance of 178.50 ft. to Corner No. 4; thence N 64° 49' E a distance of 104.57 ft. to Corner No. 5; thence N 14° 15' W a distance of 105.41 ft. to Corner No. 6, a point on line 4-5 of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence S 16° 42' E a distance of 48.55 ft. along said line 4-5 to Corner No. 7, identical with Corner No. 4 of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence S 19° 52' E a distance of 61.53 ft. to Corner No. 8, identical with Corner No. 3 of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence S 32° 18' W a distance of 11.15 ft. to Corner No. 9, identical with Corner No. 2 of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence S 61° 19' W a distance of 300.00 ft. along the original Lincoln Street boundary of the Pioneers' Home tract to Corner No. 1, the place of beginning, according to the Plat of Proposed Street Widening Project prepared by Felix J. Toner dated February 9, 1953.

TRACT II — Abutting Seward and Barracks Streets.

Beginning at Corner No. 1, which is identical with Corner No. 6, the northeast corner of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence S 22° 50' E a distance of 102.49 ft. along the westerly boundary of Barracks Street to Corner No. 2, identical with Corner No. 5 of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence S 16° 42' E distance of 15.36 ft. along the westerly boundary of Barracks Street to Corner No. 3; thence N 28° 32' W a distance of 76.26 ft. to Corner No. 4; thence along the arc of a circle whose radius is 48.00 ft. and whose center lies westerly, a distance of 69.46 ft. to Corner No. 5, a point on line 6-7 of the Pioneers' Home tract; thence N 68° 33' E a distance of 55.84 ft. along the southerly boundary of Seward

Street to Corner No. 1, the place of beginning, according to the Plat of Proposed Street Widening Project prepared by Felix J. Toner dated February 9, 1953.

Restricted deed.

Section 2. The land herein described shall be transferred and deeded to the City of Sitka, Alaska, by restrictive deed, with the use thereof restricted to the public for a public street and thoroughfare, and with the provision that the City of Sitka dedicate it to the public as a street and public thoroughfare, and if at any time it ceases to be used for that purpose, the land shall revert to the Territory of Alaska; and further provided, that the land herein conveyed shall be used for a public street and sidewalk, and the present retaining walls shall be replaced by retaining walls of similar nature and purpose according to plans to be approved by the Superintendent of the Pioneers' Home, all at no cost to the Territory of Alaska.

Execution of deed by Governor authorized.

Section 3. The Governor of the Territory is authorized, empowered and directed, immediately upon the passage and approval of the Act, to execute the necessary deed, transfer and conveyance, conveying the above-described land to the City of Sitka, Alaska, upon the terms and conditions herein expressed, and to deliver the deed to the City Clerk of the City of Sitka, Alaska.

Emergency clause.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be effective upon its passage and approval.
