2. A committee composed of the Speaker of the House as chairman, one Representative appointed by the Speaker, the President of the Senate and one Senator appointed by the President, is designated to select and purchase the plaques and do everything else necessary to accomplish the purpose herein stated.

3. The sum of \$500.00, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is appropriated to carry out the provisions of this Resolution, and the monies shall be paid by warrant drawn on the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska upon a voucher approved by the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
