HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 16

TO THE TERRITORIAL BOARD OF HEALTH:

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-first Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, Cordova is one of the principal growing communities of Alaska and is so located that it is a service center for an important section of the Territory; and

WHEREAS, existing hospital facilities at Cordova are unsatisfactory and even dangerous from the standpoints of safety and fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the people of Cordova have shown commendable community spirit by planning the construction of a new hospital and by arranging to subscribe local funds thereto; and

WHEREAS, Territorial support in this endeavor is consonant with existing programs of assistance to community hospitals;

NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska respectfully urges that there be allotted from appropriations made by the Legislature for matching local and federal funds for hospital construction the sum of \$154,000 for assistance in constructing and equipping the proposed hospital at Cordova.
