SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, there are approximately 1,500 persons employed by the various branches, departments and agencies of the Territorial government in positions of differing types of employment; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 5,000 negro residents, and 33,863 non-white native residents of the Territory of Alaska, many of whom are qualified for employment by the Territorial Government in its various positions with qualifications ranging from menial through the skilled and professional;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED by the Senate of the Territory of Alaska, the House of Representatives concurring, that we hereby request the Governor of Alaska, and the Commissioner, Director, Chief Administrator or other official in charge of employment in the Territorial Government of Alaska to be ever on the alert to avoid any discrimination for reasons of race or color, in order that the conduct of the Government of Alaska may be an example of fairness in every way in the field of employment practices;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Governor and the Director, Commissioner or other Chief Administrative Official of each Administration, Department, Commission, Board or Agency of the Territorial Government.
