

# LAWS OF ALASKA

## FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION

### CHAPTER 1

#### AN ACT

Making an appropriation of the sum of \$86,231.75 or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of any monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay the legislative expenses, and to pay the salary, per diem and expenses of members and the salaries of officers and employees of the First Extraordinary Session of the Twenty-second Legislature, and to pay any unpaid accounts or expenses of the Regular Session of the Twenty-second Legislature; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 2)

**Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$86,231.75 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay the legislative expenses and to pay the salary, per diem and expenses of members and the salaries of officers and employees of the First Extraordinary Session of the Twenty-second Legisla-

ture, and to pay any unpaid accounts or expenses of the Regular Session of the Twenty-second Legislature, such appropriation to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

(a) For the salaries of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate, \$26.00 per day for 30 days, two Assistant Clerks of the House of Representatives, \$21.00 per day for 30 days; one Assistant Secretary of

the Senate at \$21.00 per day for 30 days, the sum of .....\$ 3,450.00

(b) For the salaries of the Sergeant-at-Arms of the House of Representatives, \$18.00 per day for 30 days, and the Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate, \$18.00 per day for 30 days; the sum of .....\$ 1,080.00

(c) For the salaries of the following employees of the Senate for 30 days: three stenographer-typists at \$19.00 per day; one Engrossing Clerk and one Enrolling Clerk at \$18.00 per day; one Bill Clerk and one typist-mimeograph operator at \$17.00 per day; two messengers at \$16.00 per day; and one watchman at \$15.00 per day; the sum of .....\$ 5,220.00

(d) For the salaries of the following employees of the House of Representatives, for 30 days, two stenographers at \$19.00 per day; one Enrolling Clerk and one Engrossing Clerk at \$18.00 per day; one mimeograph operator, one Bill Clerk, one Proof Reader and three typists at \$17.00 per day; one Mail and File Clerk and two messengers at \$16.00 per day; one doorman and one watchman at \$15.00 per day; the sum of .....\$ 7,620.00

(e) For the salaries of the Chaplain of the House of Representatives, for 30 days at \$6.00 per day; and for the Chaplain of the Senate, 30 days at \$6.00 per day, the sum of .....\$ 360.00

(f) For the payment of additional services rendered by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the

Territory of Alaska during the First Extraordinary Session the sum of \$200.00 and this money is to be equally divided.

(g) For the payment of compensation to such janitors and charwomen as are necessary to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature at the First Extraordinary Session, the sum of .....\$ 1,500.00

(h) For the payment of necessary telephone service for use of the Legislature during the First Extraordinary Session, the sum of \$ 33.00

(i) For the payment of printing and binding of the Senate and House Journals, Extraordinary Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the Legislature during the First Extraordinary Session, the sum of .....\$ 19,608.75

(j) For the purchase of mimeograph paper, type writing paper, stencils, carbons and such other material and supplies and rental of public address systems as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature during the First Extraordinary Session, the sum of \$ 2,750.00

(k) For the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the rate of \$20.00 per day for the members of the Legislature, 30 days each for regular members of both Houses and 35 days for the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives, the sum of .....\$ 24,200.00

(l) For postage allowance of \$25.00 to be paid to each member of the House and Senate, as the estimated amount necessary to defray costs of mailing, telegraphing and otherwise communicating with constituents during the First Extraordinary Session, the sum of .....\$ 1,000.00

(m) For a Contingent Fund to be divided equally by House of Representatives and the Senate for use in defraying costs of extra mailing of a mass nature and hiring of additional help as needed or other contingencies and same to be drawn by the authority of the Speaker of the House of Representatives and President of the Senate, respectively, the sum of .....\$ 500.00

(n) For the payment of the sal-

aries of the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the First Extraordinary Session, at the rate of \$15.00 per day, the sum of .....\$ 18,000.00

(o) For F. I. C. A. matching, the sum of .....\$ 710.00

Section 2. The monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 2

AN ACT

To authorize departments and other agencies of the Territory to enter into agreements or contracts with each other for the purpose of furnishing necessary and authorized special or technical services, including services of employees, materials, and equipment.
