

CHAPTER 10

AN ACT

To appropriate funds for payment bounties on hair seal, wolverines, wolves and coyotes; to authorize the Treasurer to waive the provisions of Sec. 33-3-112 to 33-3-120 ACLA 1949, relative to bounty claims, and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 10)

**Be it Enacted by the Legislature
of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are hereby appropriated for the purposes hereinafter specified, and said claims are hereby approved, to-wit:

Bounty Claims; Deficiencies

Wolf and Coyote claims,
including uncertified

claims	\$10,000.00
Wolverine Claims, in- cluding uncertified claims	2,000.00
Hair Seal Claims	6,000.00
	Total \$18,000.00

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
