

CHAPTER 103

AN ACT

To amend Section 5 of Chapter 131, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, by adding a new subsection; extending the authority of the Civil Defense Director to sell, lend, transfer and deliver supplies or medicines in accordance with the policy and purposes of the Civil Defense Act.

(S. B. 139)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 5 of Chapter 131, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, is hereby amended by adding a new subsection thereto, reading as follows:

(12) To sell, lend, transfer or deliver any supplies or medicines to effectuate the policy and purposes set forth in this Act on

such terms and conditions as he shall deem reasonable. All moneys derived from the sale of supplies and medicines shall be deposited in a special fund, which shall be used by the Director to replenish and purchase the necessary supplies and medicines; provided, however, that no sale hereunder shall be for an amount below 10% of the requisition cost unless first approved by the Civil Defense Council.
