

1960. The members of the Commission shall be Territorial officers, and before entering upon the discharge of their duties, shall take such oaths of office as are prescribed for Territorial officers. The Governor may, at any time, after notice and hearing, remove any Commissioner for gross inefficiency, neglect of duty, malfeasance in office, or commission of a crime.

Upon the expiration of the term of a member, the Governor shall submit the name of a suc-

cessor for confirmation by the Legislature then in session; if the Governor does not submit such name, the incumbent shall continue to hold office and to perform the duties thereof until his successor shall be appointed and confirmed by the Legislature, as in this section provided, and no recess or interim appointments shall be made in such cases.

Section 3. The terms of office of the members of the present Commission shall terminate on the effective date of this Act.

CHAPTER 117

AN ACT

Relative to the official expenses of the Highway Engineer; Providing for the segregation and transfer of the Roads, Airfields, Water and Harbor Facilities and Aeronautical Funds; amending Section 41-3-4 ACLA 1949; declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 227)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 41-3-4 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 41-3-4. Manner of Paying Expenses. The expenses of the office of Highway Engineer shall be paid out of appropriations for that purpose from the Roads,

Airfields, Water and Harbor Facilities Fund until July 1st, 1955, at which time said fund shall be segregated and the appropriate portions thereof transferred into the Highway Fund, Water and Harbor Facilities Fund and Aeronautical Revolving Fund. After July 1st, 1955, said expenses of the office of the Highway Engineer shall be paid from the Highway Fund.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 118

AN ACT

Authorizing the Executive Director of the Legislative Council to transfer the sum of \$388.39 available in the biennial appropriation for the Legislative Council from an item containing a surplus to items where there is a deficiency; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 230)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

2. Contingent Expense .. 70.25

Section 1. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer the sum of \$388.39 available from the 1953-1955 appropriation for Legislative Council for "Salary of Director" for the following purposes:

Section 2. No transfer of funds, as above authorized, will be effective for vouchering purposes unless and until the office of the Auditor has been officially notified thereof in writing.

To cover deficiency in appropriation for:

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
