

CHAPTER 166

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$3,585.00 to the widow of M. P. Mullaney, for the unpaid accrued annual leave at the time of his death; and declaring an emergency.

(H. B. 236)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to Mrs. Nell Mullaney the sum of \$3,585.00 (being the net sum owing M. P. Mullaney for 92 days annual leave accrued and unpaid) out of any moneys in the General Fund of the Territorial

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 167

AN ACT

Making an appropriation of \$3,500.00 for expenses of the three Alaska members of the advisory committee to the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission for the biennium ending March 31, 1957.

(C. S. for H. B. 189)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

or so much thereof as needed is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the

Section 1. The sum of \$3,500.00

Office of the Governor of Alaska for the biennium beginning April 1, 1955, and ending March 31, 1957. The appropriation herein shall be used for the sole purpose of defraying the cost of transportation and per diem incurred by the three

Alaska members of the advisory committee to the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission during attendance at meetings of the commission and traveling to and from such meetings.

CHAPTER 168

AN ACT

To amend Section 2 of Chapter 107 SLA 1951, as amended by Chapter 127 SLA 1953, pertaining to the Alaska Visitors Association; and declaring an emergency.

(S. B. 86)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 107, Session Laws of Alaska, 1951, as amended by Chapter 127, Session Laws of Alaska, 1953, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. Territorial moneys in the amounts that shall be appropriated will be expended in Alaska, the United States and Canada for the purpose of promoting and publicizing Alaska's tourist attractions. Such advertising, publicity and promotional activities shall be produced, managed and distributed by or under the direc-

tion of the Alaska Visitors Association, a corporation organized under the laws of the Territory of Alaska, for the purpose of promoting Alaska's tourist industry. Territorial moneys shall be issued to said Alaska Visitors Association by warrants of the Auditor of Alaska for expenditure in accomplishing the purpose for which the corporation was organized; provided, however, such Territorial moneys shall be limited in any biennium to two times the amount contributed to and received by said association during such biennium from sources other than the Territory
