

CHAPTER 197

AN ACT

To appropriate \$1,000,000.00 to be expended under the direction of the Alaska Board of Road Commissioners for the construction of highways, roads and access roads; authorizing the Board to enter into agreements with the Federal Government to secure highway matching funds.

(S. B. 28)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund as a loan the sum of One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars for the construction of highways, roads and access roads, to be expended by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners. The aforesaid loan is to be repaid to the General Fund prior to June 30, 1957 as moneys become available from highway vehicle motor fuel tax.

Section 2. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be expended in those sections of the Territory where the need therefor is most pressing as determined by said Board and the decision of a majority thereof in regard to the said

determination shall be final and conclusive for all purposes.

Section 3. In the event it is found possible to secure Federal funds made available under any Act of the Congress to be expended in connection with or for the construction of such roads, said Board shall have power to enter into agreements with the proper Federal officials to secure such Federal funds as may be made available and agree to such conditions, transfer of all or any portion of the funds in this Act appropriated to such Federal officer or agency for expenditure thereof, and to do such other acts and things as may be necessary or required by such Acts of Congress or any regulation of the Federal government as a condition to securing such Federal funds for the purpose indicated.
