

ity Retirement Salary Increase. Those teachers who are receiving a disability retirement salary on July 1, 1955, under the provisions of Territorial Law, shall receive for life an additional monthly disability retirement salary computed as follows:

Total years of creditable service divided by twenty-five (25), multiplied by Fifty Dollars (\$50.00); Provided that for the purposes of this Act, the total years of creditable service shall not exceed twenty-five (25).

The additional disability retirement salary shall be paid from the

Territorial School Tax Fund on the first day of each month commencing August 1, 1955, pursuant to vouchers approved by the Secretary of the Teachers' Retirement System.

In the event a teacher, who is drawing a disability retirement salary, subsequently recovers from such disability, his disability retirement salary as provided in this section shall terminate on the first day of the month in which such recovery occurs.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective on the 1st day of July, 1955.

CHAPTER 58

AN ACT

To amend Chapter 57, Session Laws of Alaska 1953; adding a new paragraph pertaining to the disbursement of monies, including tuition fees; received in the operation, etc., of community colleges; and declaring an emergency.

(S. B. 135)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 8 of Chapter 57, Session Laws of Alaska 1953, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8. Community college funds to carry out the purposes of this Act shall be those provided for the University of Alaska in general appropriation acts of the legislature.

Section 2. A new paragraph is added, designated Section 9, reading as follows:

Sec. 9. All monies, including tuition fees heretofore received or which shall be received from the operations of any community colleges as established, operated and maintained under this Act, shall be placed in a separate fund from the community college funds appropriated to carry out the purposes of Chapter 57, Session Laws of Alaska 1953. The monies in the separate fund shall be disbursed by the Board of Regents in the proportionate amount of

twenty-five percent to the participating school district and seventy-five percent to the community college fund.

Section 3. Section 9 of Chapter 57, Session Laws of Alaska 1953, is hereby redesignated Section 10, reading as follows:

Sec. 10. This Act shall be known as the "Community College Act of the Territory of Alaska."

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 59

AN ACT

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners to regulate the use of roads in tourist, trailer and other, similar-type camps when such roads are used by, or open to, the general public.

(S. B. 136)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Road Commissioners is hereby authorized to promulgate regula-

tions governing the use of roads in tourist, trailer and other type camps when such roads, whether public or private, in or through said camps are used by, or open to, the general public.
