

CHAPTER 88

AN ACT

Establishing hours of work for Territorial employees; authorizing such employees to work part-time with other Territorial offices; providing for compensatory leave; repealing and reenacting Section 11-5-3 ACLA 1949.

(S. B. 129)

**Be it Enacted by the Legislature
of the Territory of Alaska:**

Section 1. Section 11-5-3 ACLA 1949, is repealed, and a new Section 11-5-3, in lieu thereof, is enacted to read as follows:

**Sec. 11-5-3. Hours of Work:
Part-Time Employment: Compensatory Leave.**

(a) The regular hours of work for Territorial office employees shall be from 8:30 A. M. until 12:00 Noon and from 1:00 P. M. until 5:00 P. M. daily except on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays; Provided, however, that field offices of the Department of Taxation shall be open from 9:00 A. M. to 12:00 Noon on Sat-

urdays, and other Territorial offices may be open during those hours in the discretion of the responsible executive officer of each Department.

(b) Territorial employees may be employed on a part-time basis by offices in other than the regular hours of work by offices of the Territory other than the one for which regularly employed.

(c) The heads of Territorial departments of agencies may require employees to work in excess of the regular hours of employment, but such employees shall be entitled to an equal amount of leave time as compensation for such work.
