

to obtain advances of funds from the Federal Unemployment Account for the purposes of (a) reimbursing the General Fund of the Territory to the extent of the loans made under the provision of Section 1 hereof; and (b) maintaining sufficient funds in the Unemployment Compensation Fund to pro-

vide for the prompt payment of unemployment insurance benefits.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 9

AN ACT

To refund unearned liquor license fees paid by various applicants for licenses for the calendar year ending December 31, 1954; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

(S. B. 5)

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to each of the legal entities hereinafter named, the amount of money hereinafter set forth to the right of the name of each of them, for the purpose of reimbursing each of them for unearned portions of license fees for liquor licenses paid by them for licenses expiring December 31, 1954,

namely:

- Ada Sweum\$ 300.00
- Spenard Cocktail Lounge,
Inc. and Lucille Fox .. 1,000.00
- Hitchin' Post, Inc. 1,000.00
- Fireside Lounge, Inc. 1,000.00
- Forest Park Country Club 950.00

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
