That for the purpose of defraying the cost of transportation of said committee there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,500.00, or so much thereof

as may be necessary for such purpose.

3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
