

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

**Be it Resolved by the Legislature
of the Territory of Alaska:**

WHEREAS, copies of the Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated 1949 and other books were furnished to each member of the Twenty-second Session of the Alaska Legislature for the use of the members in consideration of legislation before them;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of said members to take the said Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated and other books to their respective homes at the end of the session; and

WHEREAS, it is the further desire of said members to receive the printed and bound Journals of their

respective Houses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that each member of the Twenty-second Session of the Alaska Legislature, Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate be permitted to keep the Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated and other books used by him or her during the present session; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor shall distribute copies of the printed and bound Senate Journals to each member of the Senate and copies of the printed and bound House Journals to each member of the House of Representatives.
