## HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 1

**To the Territorial Highway Engineer:**

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Alaska, respectfully represents:

WHEREAS, the Cache Creek road, connecting Talkeetna, Alaska, with the Cache Creek mining area is in a serious state of disrepair, and

WHEREAS, the future of the mining industry in this area as well as the welfare of the people, being several hundred in number entirely dependent upon mining for a livelihood, is in jeopardy as a result of this serious condition, and

WHEREAS, the Talkeetna mining

district has for a period of many years generously contributed in the way of taxation to the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, this requested investment in road rehabilitation will be more than returned to the Treasury in the preservation of industry and safeguard of welfare,

THEREFORE, we direct that you expend such sums as are necessary to rehabilitate the Cache Creek Road its full length, and further direct that you commence such program in the early spring of 1955 as soon as is practical.

## HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 2

**To the Honorable Dwight D. Eisenhower, President of the United**

**States; to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the**

**House of Representatives of the Congress of the United States; and to the Honorable Douglas McKay, Secretary of the Interior:**

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-second Session assembled, respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, the development of the public lands in the United States historically has followed quickly after ownership and possession of these lands by the several states; and,

WHEREAS, the Territory of Alaska is ready and able to assume responsibility of using and developing the public lands therein,

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska urges that H. R. No. 246, now pending before the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United States be passed and approved.

### HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. 3

**To the Commissioner of Education:** outside toilet,

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Alaska, respectfully represents:

WHEREAS, Talkeetna is a town on the Alaska Railroad of approximately 100 population, and

WHEREAS, the school facilities are inadequate and unsanitary, with

THEREFORE, we direct that you forthwith expend such sums as are necessary to provide an adequate indoor lavatory with running water. We further direct that this be done immediately and not next year.
